





## At the Doctor's Office

- Always take your updated **Emory Healthcare Universal Medication Form**. This will tell your doctor everything you are taking, including prescription medicines, over-the-counter medicines, and herbals.
- Tell your doctor about any allergies or reactions that you have had to medicine in the past.



## In the Hospital

- When you are admitted to the hospital, take your updated **Emory Healthcare Universal Medication Form**, or bring all of your medicines in the original bottles. Include over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and herbals.
- Tell your doctor or nurse about any allergies or reactions that you have had to medicine in the past. Also, write these on your **Emory Healthcare Universal Medication Form**.
- If you feel that any medicine is making you sick or causing you pain, tell the doctor or nurse right away.
- When you are being sent home from the hospital, ask your doctor or nurse to clearly tell you what medicines you should be taking, and how to take them. Ask for an updated **Emory Healthcare Universal Medication Form** before you leave the hospital.
- Keep your **Emory Healthcare Universal Medication Form** updated.
