Staff at the inpatient Psychiatric and Neuropsychiatric units at Wesley Woods Geriatric Hospital are trained to evaluate and treat patients who suffer from acute symptoms of depression, dementia and other psychiatric disorders. Each unit has 22 beds with a mixture of private and semi-private rooms.

The primary goal of inpatient treatment is to evaluate and stabilize the individual's acute psychiatric symptoms through a combination of clinical assessment, medication adjustment and interdisciplinary treatments. The length of stay is approximately one week and is dependant upon the patient's response to treatment.

When Making a Referral

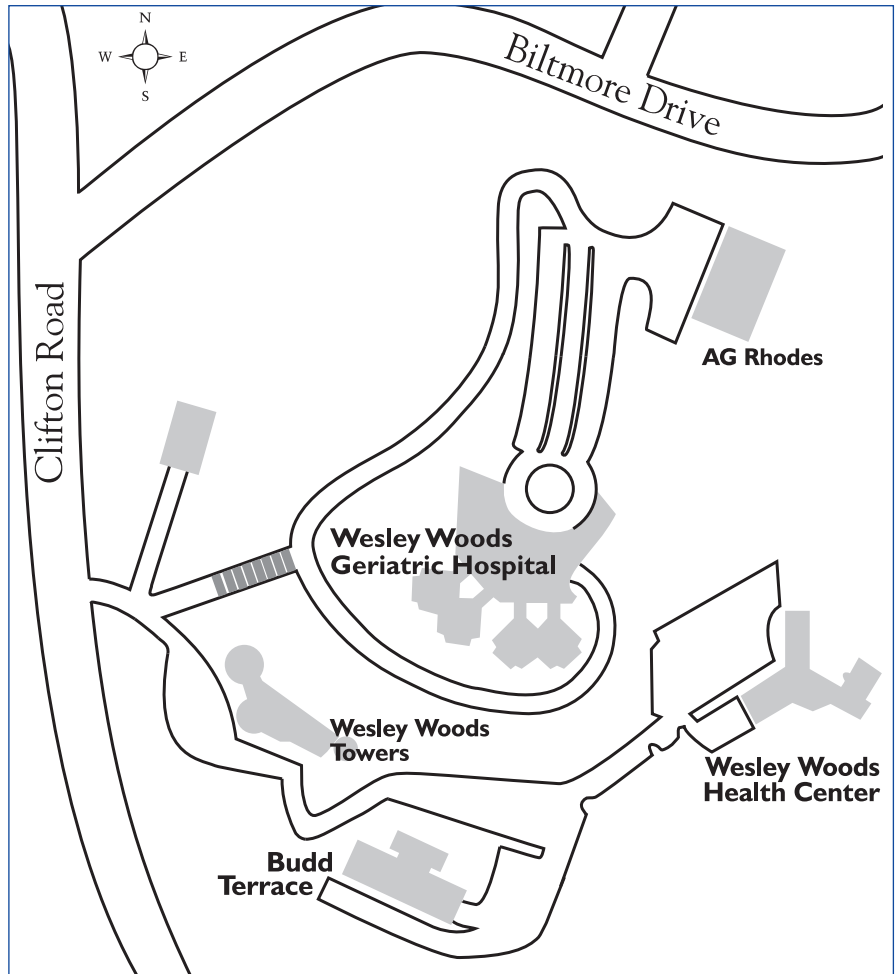
Referrals to the Wesley Woods Geriatric Inpatient Psychiatry Units are accepted 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. To initiate a referral, please call 404-728-6222 and a staff member will assist you. To help speed up the referral process, please be prepared to fax the following information:

- Demographics sheet
- History and physical (if applicable)
- Any recent labs or X-rays (if applicable)
- Two to three days of physician and nursing documentation
- A list of current medications
- Vital signs
