

The Emory Adult Congenital Heart Center

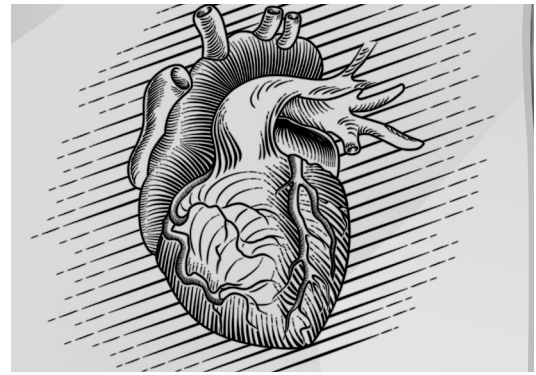
The Emory Adult Congenital Heart (EACH) Center is an internationally recognized cardiology service that specializes in the care of adults with congenital heart defects (CHDs). The EACH Center is the only adult congenital heart disease (ACHD) program in the state of Georgia, is one of the largest in the country and is rapidly growing:

- Approximately 2,250 patients currently followed
- Approximately 1,750 clinic visits conducted each year
- Approximately 100 ACHD surgeries performed each year

The Center features a multidisciplinary management team that includes both adult and pediatric cardiologists, congenital cardiac surgeons, electrophysiologists, interventional cardiologists, nurse practitioners (NPs), nurses, social workers and echocardiographers. We also work with collaborative partners who have a special interest and expertise in managing adults with CHDs from a range of other specialties.

Some of the Services Provided Include:

- Medical and surgical management of moderate to complex CHDs
- Congenital cardiac surgery
- Multidisciplinary management of late complications of a diverse group of CHDs
 - Arrhythmias (including device management)
 - Advanced heart failure
 - Pulmonary hypertension
 - Cyanotic heart disease
 - Liver health issues
 - Neuropsychological issues
 - Blood disorders
 - Lung complications
- Women's health services
 - Contraception counseling



- High-risk pregnancy counseling and management
- Genetics counseling
- Fetal echocardiography and prenatal counseling
