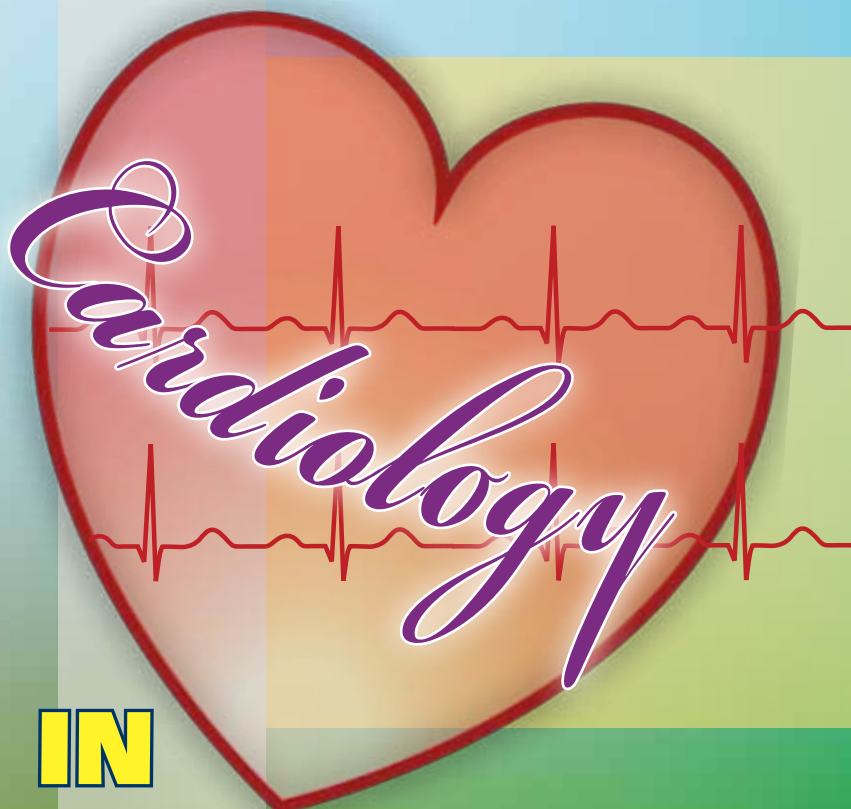

# General Information

## GENERAL INFORMATION

With the restructuring of health care in the United States, one of the major changes in patient care has been a shift from subspecialty care to primary care. In addition, cardiovascular disease remains the leading cause of death and disability in the U.S. As a result, much of the burden of caring for patients with cardiovascular disease will fall on primary care physicians. This meeting is designed to provide an update in the diagnosis and management of cardiovascular disease for primary care providers.

At the Cardiology in Primary Care Conference, you will hear from nationally renowned speakers on a wide variety of topics. Areas of focus include stress testing, heart disease in women, lipid-lowering therapy, atrial fibrillation, post-hospital discharge cardiac care, peripheral vascular disease and many others. Case discussions with expert panels will also highlight key concepts in cardiovascular disease.
