

Who we are

Emory University Hospital Midtown (EUHM) is well known for services in cardiology, cardiac surgery, gastroenterology, neurosurgery, oncology, orthopaedics and emergency medicine. Women's services include prenatal and postnatal education, bone density testing, mammography and obstetrics, with specialization in high-risk pregnancy.

EUHM has 529 beds, including 86 ICU beds, a level III neonatal intensive care unit and four hyperbaric oxygen units.
